REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Human rights in southern Lebanon

Report of the Secretary-General

1. By its decision 1988/44, the Economic and Social Council took note of the report of the Commission on Human Rights containing resolution 1988/60 of 10 March 1988 on the situation of human rights in southern Lebanon. In paragraph 4 of the resolution, the Commission requested the Secretary-General: (a) to bring the resolution to the attention of the Government of Israel and to invite it to provide information concerning the extent of its implementation thereof; and (b) to report to the General Assembly at its forty-third session and to the Commission on Human Rights at its forty-fifth session on the results of his efforts in that regard.
2. In accordance with the request, the Secretary-General, on 22 July 1988, addressed a note verbale to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the State of Israel, in which he requested the Minister for Foreign Affairs to inform him on the extent of the implementation of the resolution by the Government of Israel.
3. No reply had been received at the time of the preparation of the present report.
