<u>Final communiqué of the Meeting of Ministers and Heads of Delegation of the</u> <u>Non-Aligned Countries to the Forty-first Session of the United Nations</u> <u>General Assembly held on 2 October 1986 in New York</u>

The Ministers for Foreign Affairs and heads of delegation of non-aligned countries to the forty-first session of the General Assembly met in New York on 2 October 1986 to consider their actions on issues before the present session of the General Assembly of special concern to non-aligned countries.

The Ministers expressed satisfaction at the positive response of an overwhelming majority of speakers in the general debate in the forty-first session of the General Assembly in support of the convening of the International Peace Conference on the Middle East.
