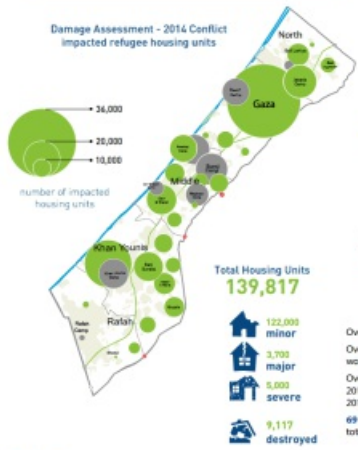
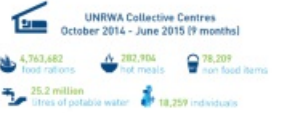


2014 Gaza conflict and UNRWA shelter response

Over 78,000 refugee families received payments for repair works
 Over 47,000 refugee families have not received payments for repair works due to lack of funding
 Over 12,500 refugee families received rental subsidy payments in 2014 and over 9,000 received further rental subsidy payments in 2015
 69 refugee families received payments for the reconstruction of totally damaged homes
