May I refer to your letter of the 10th March in which you communicated to me the views of the Commission on certain observations made in my [letter of the 27th February](#) relating to the proposed formation of militias in Palestine.

I have now received a telegram from Jerusalem informing me that the supplementary information requested by the Commission in paragraphs 2 (a) and 2 (b), Mad. 4, of your letter under reference has been supplied to Colonel Rocher Lund, of the Secretariat advance party in Jerusalem, by the Government of Palestine.
