# UNITED NATIONS FALESTINE COMOISSION ADVANCE P IRTY 

## ACCOMMODATION OF THE COMMISSION

FROGRESS REFOCT NO. 1

1. The question of housing the Comission was discussed at several meetings between Mr. Azcarate and Mr. Stavropoulos and Sir Henry Gurney and the Director of Fublic Works. During the discussions the Falestine Government expressed a doubt whether the Commission would like to sit in Jerusalem. The Palestine Government is sceking a truce between the two elemencs of the population of Jerusalem, and negotiations are in progress. They seen to fear that if a truce were called and subsequently the Comassion were to arrive in Jerusalem; fighting would start again. There night also be some unwillingriess to receive the Commission in Jerusalem on 1 Mas while the Palestine Government will be winding up.
2. The only suggestion regarding accomodation of the Commissicn made by the Palestine Government is Wilhelme ' Wilhelma is a small village at a distance of three to four miles from Lydda airport, built by German sett,lers. Although inside the proposed Jewish. State's boundaries, it is surrounded by Arab villages and lies in a completely Arab area. As steted in tile first general report of the Advance Farty, Wilhelma was visited by members of the Advance Party. It consists of one main road crossed at a junction by a shorter raad. It is inhabited today by about 270 gerrans. The intention of the Falestine Government is that these Germans should be transferred to Australia or Germany, even if the Comission does not wish to use Wilhelma. There are altogether about 55 houses, 25 of which only have insicie sanitation and ruhning water. The 55 houses have about 228 rooms. Only, some of those rooms are adequately furnished. There is no electricity and there are no telephones.

## 3. Wilhelma presents the following defects:

(a) It lies inside an Arab area in flat country, and as a result a strong guard would be needed for the security of the Commission.
(b) It has no electricity
(c). It has no telephones
(d) Inadequate furniture
(e) Only 25 houses have inside sanitation
(f) Caterint will have to be provided on a large scale.

Given time and money, some of the above defects may be eradicated. However; it will be exceedingly difficult, if not impossible, to maintain telephone communications with the rest of the country and the outside world. 4. Notwithstanding the above defects, Wilneima may have to be used if nothing else is found in the meanwhile, at least for the pertod until 15 May. Regarding the housing of the Commission after 15 Kay, contact was made with the Manager of the King David Hotel with a viaw to continuing the leass of ${ }^{-}$ the hotel after it is relinguished by the Palestine Government and the British military authorities. The Manager of the Hotel was asked to submit estimates for housing the Comission in the Hotel and for catering. It was understood that part of the hotel would be used as offices. Should the Hotel be leased, the problem of housing the Comission would, in principle, be solved. If further accommodation is required, it may be found in adjoin ing houses to be leased or requisitioned. It should be pointed out, however, that this would be a very costly transaction. At present the Hotel is used as Government offices and there are about 400 civil servants and officers working in it. The Manager is going to submit his estimates within the next ten days, after having consulted with-the Directors of the Company. 5. The German Hospital, Augusta Victoria, seems to be out of the question. Not only has it no furniture and other accommodation, as has the King David Hotel, but also it entails comutation through a thickly populated Arab district, which would make very difficult for the Jewish element the collabore ation with the Commission.
6. On being asked by the Advance Party, the Chief Secretary answered that he regretted that at present he is unable to suggest any alternative to Wilhelma However, a meeting has been arranged for tomorrow with the Chief Secretary to consider the question again.
