You will no doubt have seen a copy of the official letter No. 56/544/16/48 of the 20th March which was sent from this Delegation to the Secretary-General of the United Mations, informing him that it was proposed to apply Parts I, II and III of the General Agreement on Taxiffs and Trade provisionally in respect of the Mandated Taxifory of Palestine in accordance with paragraph 2 of the Protocol of Provisional Application of the Agreement.

2. I now enclose for the information of the Commission a copy of an Order made by the High Commissioner in Council under Section 5 of the Castoms, Tariff and Exemption Ordinance, 1937, giving effect in Palestine to these tariff exendments, which were brought into force on the 25th Harch, 1948.
