My dear Bunche,

Would you be good enough to inform the Commission that the following communique will be released in Jerusalem at 1.30 p.m. (Palestine time) on the 12th May:-

"Legally the Mandate terminates immediately after midnight on the night of the 14th/15th May. In consequence, His Excellency the High Commissioner will leave Jerusalem for Haifa on 14th May and will sail from Haifa in H.N.S. "Luryalus" at midnight. The withdrawal of troops from Jerusalem and parts of Falestine will also commence on 14th May."
