My dear Bancho,

You will remember that in a letter dated the 23rd February, Sir Alexander Cadogan forwarded a note to Monsieur Raul Riez de Medina containing the answers to certain questions relating to public information services and facilities in Palestine. On the 3rd March, I supplemented this information in a further letter which I sent to Monsieur Raul Riez de Medina.

2. Question 3 of the questionnaire received from Monsieur de Medina asked for information relating to personnel of certain Departments of the Government of Palestine. I now enclosed four lists marked A to D, giving the information requested in respect of the Department of Broadcasting, the Public Information Office, the Department of Printing and Stationery and the Department of Posts and Telegraphs.

3. I also enclose for the information of the Commission, marked E and F, copies of letters which have been sent to the Consuls General of Czechoslovakia and Syria in Jerusalem relating to their applications for the installation of wireless transmitters and receivers in their Consulates General.
