Occumulation Received from United Kingdom Delegation Concerning Public Information Services in Peleatine

The following communication, concerning public information services and facilities in Falestine, has been received from Mr. Flatcher-Cooks of the United Kingdom Delegation.

My dear Bunche,

May I refer to my letter of the 22nd March with which was enclosed information in enswer to Question 8 of the questionnaire received from Monsieur de Medina relating to public information services and facilities in Palestins.

2. I have now received the following information in reply to Question 9, which read as follows:

"What facilities and equipment does the Palestine Administration now possess in the following caregories: -

- (a) Sound recording and motion picture camera
- (b) Motion picture laboratories and photographic dark rooms
- (c) Mobile loud-speaker or visual information unites."

3. The replies are as follows: -

- (a) (1) All sound recording in Palestine for Government Departmentsis put out on contract to private concerns.
 - (ii) The Public Information Office possesses the following equipment: -
 - 1 16mm. Bell & Howell Camera with 3 lenses, Kinema size, clock type spring.
 - 2 Projectors 35 mm. sound Devry portable, installed in cinema wans (2 15 cwt. Morris, on loan from the Army).
 - 3 16mm. Projectors, Victor sound with loud-speaker and transformers.
 - 1 16 mm. eilent projector Agfa.
 - 1 35 mm. slide printing machine for Leica negatives.
 - 1 Leica 35 mm. alide projector.

- (111) The Palestine Police have a mobile cinema consisting of 2 16 mm Victor projectors with all the necessary equipment
- (b) (1) The Public Information Office has a dark room complete
 with the following equipment: -
 - 1 Vertical enlarger 13x18 cm
 - 1 Miniature enlarger for 6x9 negatives and 6x6 negatives
 - (ii) The Public Information Office also has the following photographic equipment: -
 - 1 Sanderson's tropical camera 9x12 cm.
 - 6 Double plate holders
 - 1 Magazine for 12 plates with 2 lenses
 - 1 Schneider Kener 15 cm 4.5 with Comore and compound shutters.
 - 1 Tella-Tessa 32 cm. 6.3 with Comore and compound shutters
 - 1 Studio camera stand
 - 2 Medalist cameras No. 2 with coated lane
 - 1 Argo 45 mm. camera with flash gun.
 - 3 Watson document copying cameras. 35mm 200 ft. reels automatic focussing and winding
 - (111) The Palestine Museum (which is under the direction of the Director of the Department of Antiquities) has the following equipment: -
 - 1 Camera 13x18 cms. Universal Jewel Ikon with 12 double plate and 3 lenses and a number of filters for scientific recording.
 - 1 Camera Linhoff 9x12 cms, with single plate holders, a
 15 cm. Tessa lane and a 15 cm. Dalmayer with wide angle lens
 - 2 Medalist cameras No.2 with filters and flash gum.
 - 3 Rollicord cameras Eo.1 6x6 cm. and 1 Telle-Dalon Dalmayer for the 9x12 cm. camera.

- 2 Blids projectors for English and American size.
- 1 Aldis Epidiascope for prints and slide projection.

Derk Rock equipment

- 1 Horizontal enlarger from half plate downwards
- 1 Ensign for 6x6 cm. negatives.
- (iv) The Palestine Police have a first-class photographic laboratory and dark room.
- (a) The Public Information Office has two loud-speakers attached to its mobile cinema equipment.
