Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. 406 of 5th April to the District Commissioner of the Jerusalem District requesting, permission to establish a wireless transmitter aid receiver in your Consulate General.

2. I am to inform you that if you will apply to the Postmaster General, who is the competent authority, a licence will be issued subject to acceptance of the following conditions:-

(a) that the type, wavelength and power of the transmitter shall be agreed with the Postmaster General.

(b) that the installation shall not be used before 15th May except by prior agreement with this Government and after 15th May except with the agreement of the successor authority.
