EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Introduction

Following the kidnapping of an Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) solider by three Palestinian militants, the IDF launched a military offensive in the Gaza strip on 28 June 2006 codenamed "Operation Summer Rains." In addition to killing over 200 Palestinians, including 44 children, the operation resulted in extensive damage to Palestinian infrastructure and economy in the Gaza strip.

In an effort to account for the extent of the physical and material damage that resulted from the military operations, the UNDP's Programme of Assistance to the Palestinian People (PAPP) immediately commenced an extensive damage assessment exercise that covered the entire geographic area of the Gaza strip. While this exercise is still ongoing, this document reports some of the salient initial findings of the assessment yielded thus far. The damage was assessed across sectors and geographic areas. The estimated total cost of the damage assessed for the **period between June 28 and August 27, 2006** is around **US\$ 46 million**.

Assessment Focus and Methodology

The primary focus of the exercise was to assess the damage to 6 sectors; namely, municipal infrastructure, housing, public buildings, agriculture, energy and industry. The assessment was divided across 5 distinct geographic areas in the Gaza strip, namely the officially established Governorates: Gaza, Rafah, Khan Younis, Middle and North.

Over 25 UNDP professional engineers and programme specialists were involved in the exercise. The methodology used for assessing the damage in all the sectors, except the agricultural sector, involved site and field visits to every damaged location, costing and recording of physical damages. The assessment of damages to the agricultural sector was done in collaboration with the Palestinian Authority and Agricultural NGO's, followed by independent site visits to validate the data received. As clearly reflected in the report, the teams extensively documented and recorded each individual site visit and assessment.

It is important to note that the figures contained herewith reflect the **actual estimated costs of damage** and not estimates for the required repairs.

Damage across Sectors

The initial damage estimates per sector hitherto yielded are:

- Municipal infrastructure (including bridges water and wastewater lines and roads)
 US\$ 8 million
- 2. **Energy** (including the electricity lines and power station) **US\$ 8 million**
- 3. **Agriculture** (including olives and citrus orchards, greenhouses, poultries and livestock farms, water wells) **US\$ 23.5 million**
- 4. Housing US\$ 2 million
- 5. Public buildings (both governmental and NGO) US\$ 4.2 million; and
- 6. Industry US\$ 0.3 million

Damage per Governorate

The damage estimates per Governorate are:

- 1. Gaza US\$ 13.5
- 2. Middle US\$12 million
- 3. Rafah US\$ 9.6 million
- 4. North US\$ 6.6 million
- 5. Khan Younis US\$ 4.2 millions

The report also provides an analysis of a sectorial breakdown across the governorates, which reveals that the sectoral damage varies from one governorate to the other.

BACKGROUND

Following the kidnapping of an Israeli solider by three Palestinian militants from Gaza, the IDF launched a military offensive on June 28, 2006 codenamed "operation summer rains." The operation has been ongoing and has resulted in the killing of over 200 Palestinians, including 44 children. It has also resulted in substantive damage to



the infra structure in the Gaza Strip, as well as every economic sector including agriculture and industry. Most noteworthy is the destruction of the power station in the Gaza strip, which provides electricity for over 1 million residents, as well as the private and public sectors.

In addition to the damages incurred in the infrastructure, the GOI of Israel imposed a very strict policy of closure, which resulted in serious

shortages of materials, including food rations and construction materials. As a result of this closure the production sectors such as: industry, agriculture, and construction have been severely impeded. For example, only 17% of Gaza's production is exported through Karni crossing, the only access point for goods in and out of Gaza.

To take stock of the material damage to infra structure in the Gaza strip in the past two months, UNDP's Programme of Assistance to the Palestinian People (PAPP) launched an extensive damage assessment exercise that covered the entire geographic area of the Gaza Strip, focusing on six important sectors: municipal infrastructure, housing, public buildings, agriculture, energy and industry. A team of 25 engineers and professionals are involved



in this ongoing exercise, and have been reporting their findings on a biweekly basis. The estimated total cost of the damage assessed for the **period between June 28 and August 27, 2006** is around **US\$ 46 million**.

This report provides an outline of some the salient findings for damage in the aforementioned period. It is important to note that the figures provided reflect the cost of the physical damage, and not the cost of the repairs. It is also important to note that these figures do not account for the aggregated economic losses that result from the damage such as the loss of income and production.


Sectors Damaged in the Gaza Strip

The affected sectors shown in the pie chart below include:

- 1. **Municipal infrastructure** including bridges, water and sewage lines and roads with total damage cost of US\$8 million.
- 2. **Energy** including the electricity lines and power station with total damage cost of around US\$8 million.
- 3. **Agriculture** including olives and citrus orchards, greenhouses, poultries and livestock farms, water wells, irrigation networks and fences with a total damage estimate of US\$23.5 million.
- 4. **Housing** with total damage cost of around US\$2 million.
- 5. **Public Buildings** including both government and NGO buildings with total damage estimate of US\$4.2 million. and
- 6. **The industrial sector** such as workshops and small factories, with a total damage of around US\$0.3 million.


As can be seen in pie chart, the agricultural sector has sustained the greatest percentage of the damage, followed by the infrastructure and power and energy sectors.

Damages Occurred in the Gaza Strip Governorates

The damages classified geographically, along the 5 Governorates of the Gaza Strip are included. The total cost of damages in the 5 Governorates is estimated to be around US\$ 46 million. Gaza and the Middle Governorates have been the most affected as the total damages in these two Governorates is estimated to be around US\$ 13.5 and 12 million respectively. The losses in Rafah Governorate are estimated to be around US\$ 9.6 million, while in the North and Khan Younis Governorates, the cost of damages is estimated to be US\$ 6.6 million in North and US\$ 4.2 millions in Khan Younis.


Sectoral Breakdown across Governorates


To get a clearer picture of the varying degrees of damage, the sectors were also





analyzed in each individual Governorate. As can be seen from the pie charts below, the distribution of damage across sectors varies from one governorate to another. For example, the greatest percentage of damage in the Governorate of Rafah was in the Agricultural sector, while in the Gaza Governorate, the greatest percentage of damage was in the infrastructure sector. The Governorate of Khan Younis' greatest percentage of damage was incurred


in the power and energy sector.
