100 (1953). Resolution of 27 October 1953

[S/3128]

The Security Council,

Having taken note of the report of the Chief of Staff of the United Nations Truce Supervision Organization in Palestine dated 23 October 1953,^{1/}

Desirous of facilitating the consideration of the question, without however prejudicing the rights, claims or position of the parties concerned,

1. *Deems it desirable to that end that the works started in the demilitarized zone on 2 September 1953 should be suspended during the urgent examination of the question by the Security Council;*

2. *Notes with satisfaction the statement made by the Israel representative at the 631st meeting regarding the undertaking given by his Government to suspend the works in question during that examination;*

3. *Relies on ^{2/} the Chief of Staff of the Truce Supervision Organization to inform it regarding the fulfilment of that undertaking.*

Adopted unanimously at the 631st meeting.
