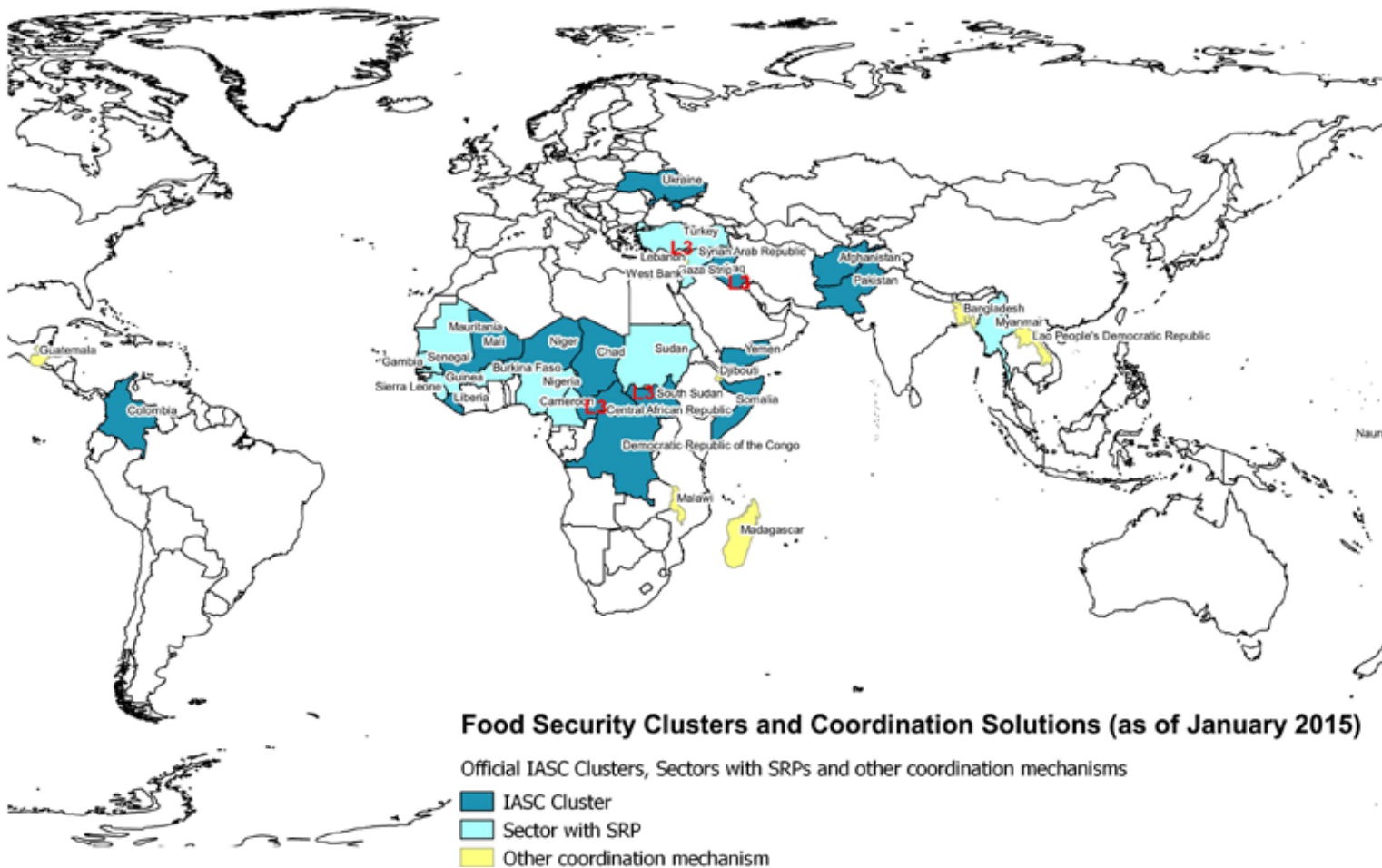





Country-level Food Security Coordination

As of March 2015, country-level Food Security Clusters/Sectors are on average only **20%** funded while coordination remains critical.



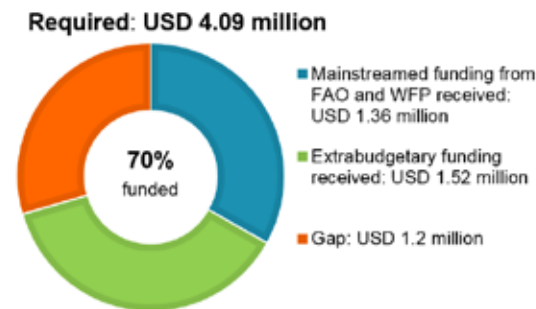
