

Situation Overview


On 7 July 2014 a humanitarian emergency was declared in the Gaza Strip, following a severe escalation in hostilities involving aerial intense Israeli and bombardment and Palestinian rocket firing.

The targeting and destruction of residential properties in Gaza has been the main cause of civilian casualties, raising concerns regarding respect for the principle of distinction.

Palestinian Casualties




Known needs, response and funding to date

Needs Response Children require psychosocial support. UNICEF and Child Protection Protection Cluster are mobilizing resources. The cluster has a stock for 70,000 342 families (2,050 people) need non-food items. Cash assistance is needed to cover rental fees. Of the SRP total request of \$390 million, \$221 million (57%) is for projects targeting the Gaza Strip specifically. Of this \$221 million, less than 30% has been received to date. A further \$68 million is requested for projects targeting the Gaza Strip and the West Bank jointly.
