

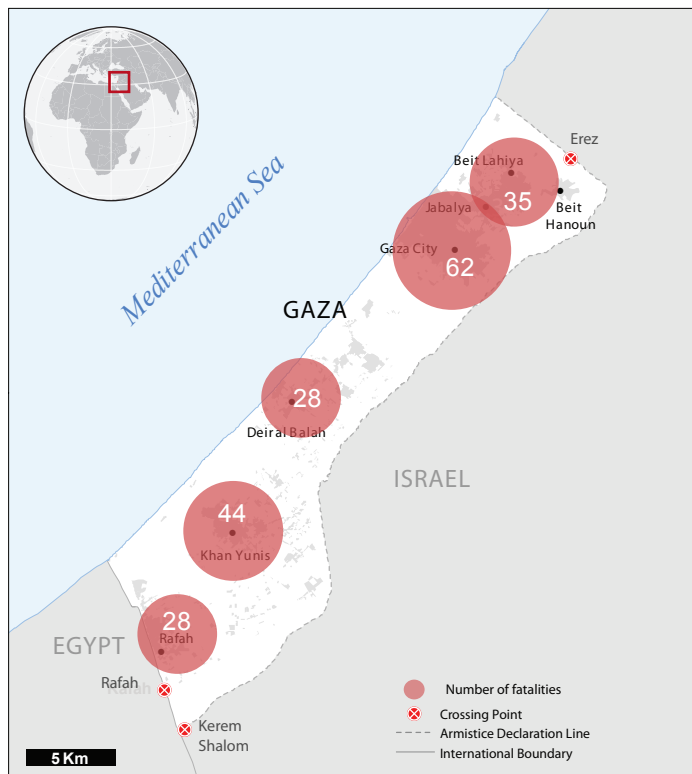

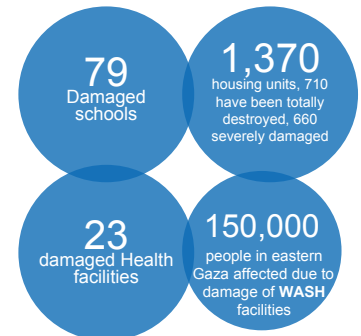

Situation Overview

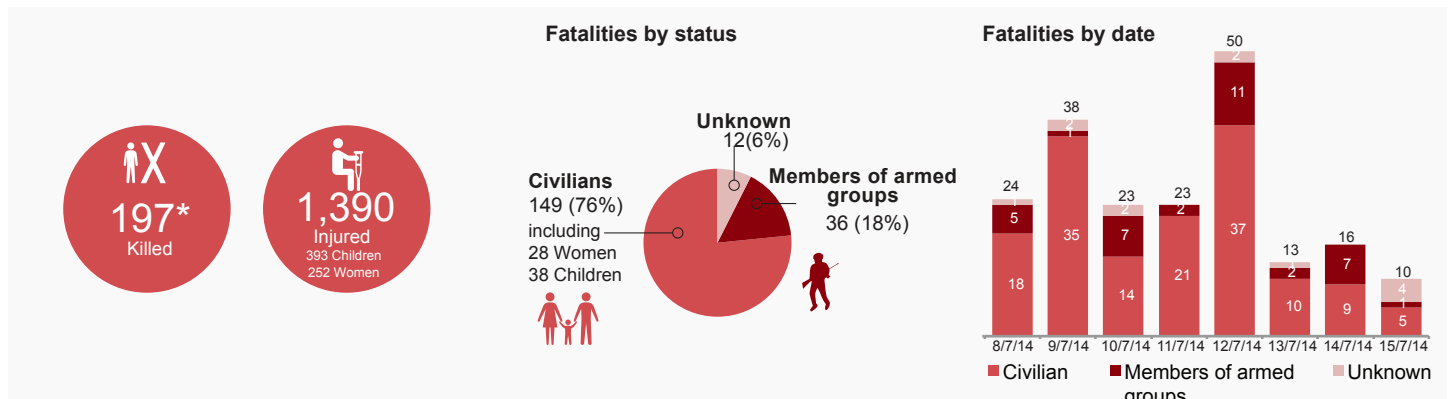
Tens of thousands of Palestinians from northern and central Gaza have fled their homes, following warnings from the Israeli military, with more than 18,000 individuals taking shelter in 21 UNRWA schools. In addition, 8,200 people have been displaced following the destruction or the damage to their homes.

Damage to health, education, water and sanitation facilities, and electricity infrastructure make it increasingly difficult to provide even the most basic services for the civilian population, with hundreds of thousands of Gazans without water.

Needs, response and funding

	Needs	Response
Protection	25,300 children require specialised psychosocial support ; Approx.	Psychosocial teams have reached 344 children
Shelter and NFI	1,370 families (8,200 persons) are in need of emergency NFI kits, 12,000 families are in need of NFI repair items. Cash assistance (US\$ 6.85 m) to cover rental fees and urgent expenses, is needed.	UNRWA is currently providing shelter and NFIs, including hygiene kits, to 18,000 displaced persons from northern Gaza
Health	Gaza requires (US\$4 3.2 m) monthly to secure the needed drugs and disposables. 8 anesthesia machines, 10 ventilators, 5 electrosurgical units, 20 vital sign monitors, ECG machines, 5 defibrillator machines urgently needed.	19 UNRWA clinics are operational. Emergency fuel (40,765 litres of diesel) delivered to critical health facilities. 500 blood units delivered to Al Shifa Hospital in Gaza
WASH	Water supply to 150,000 people in eastern Gaza City and to 20,000 people in Rafah and Middle area cut due to damage to WASH infrastructure.	ICRC supported emergency repairs to WASH infrastructure in Gaza, improving the situation for over 90,000 people.
Food	20,000 Displaced people in need of emergency food assistance	Three trucks provided by WFP, delivered to UNRWA shelters. 10,386 beneficiaries receiving food rations through 7 UNRWA distribution centres.
Funding	US\$ 22 million urgently needed by UNRWA to continue its operations in Gaza and to cover underfunded projects	2 US\$ million worth of proposals are being processed by ERF/OCHA to meet underfunded projects in the SRP

oPt Funding by sector (in million US\$)

Of the SRP total request of \$390 million, \$221 million (57%) is for projects targeting the Gaza Strip specifically. Of this \$221 million, less than 30% has been received to date. A further \$68 million is requested for projects targeting the Gaza Strip and the West Bank jointly.
