## **Gaza Strip: Palestinians Internally Displaced Persons** Locations of Collective Centres and "Pre-fabricated housing units" Sites (19 January 2015) The July-August 2014 hostilities caused significant displacement in the Gaza Strip. At the height of the conflict, some 500,000 Palestinians were internally displaced. As of January 2015, more than 100,000, Beit Lahiya whose homes were severely damaged or destroyed Erez remained displaced. IDPs are sheltering in UNRWA Collective Centres, with North host families, in pre-fabricated housing units, in rented apartments and some in make-shift shelters in the Beit Lahiya rubble of their homes. They require food assistance, non-food items, rental subsidies, cash assistance to carry out basic repairs, access to basic services and <u>657</u> Beit Hanoun more.
