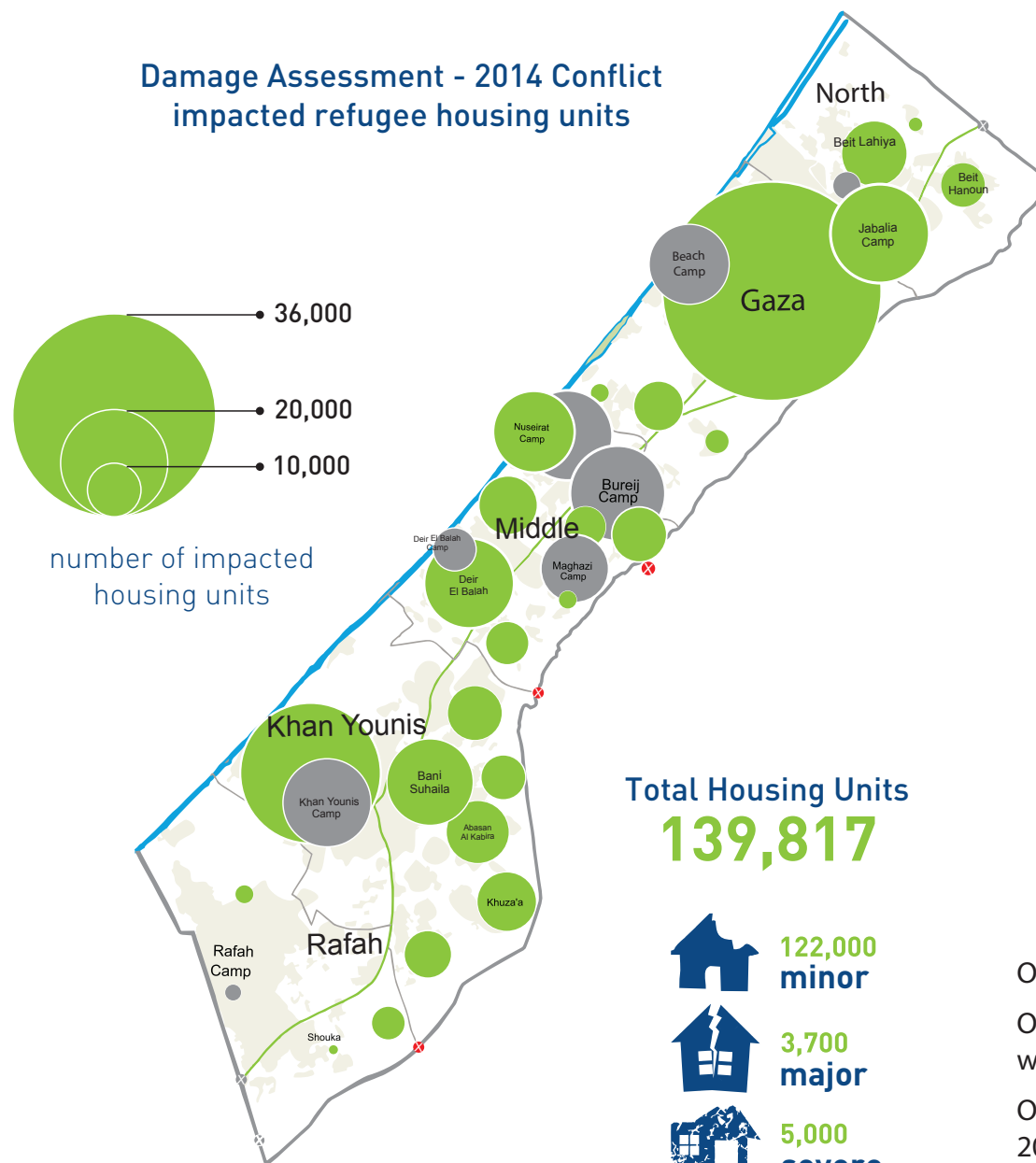


2014 gaza conflict and unrwa shelter response

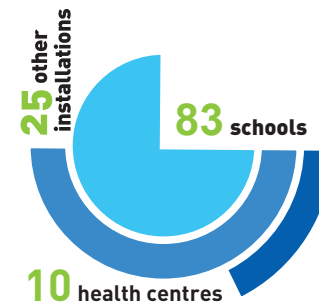

Over **78,600** refugee families received payments for repair works

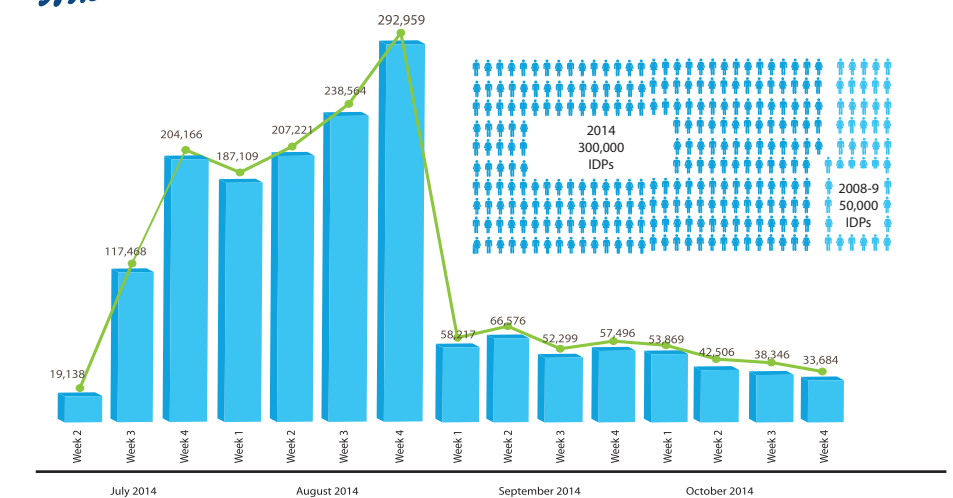
Over **47,000** refugee families have not received payments for repair works due to lack of funding

Over **12,500** refugee families received rental subsidy payments in 2014 and over **9,000** received further rental subsidy payments in 2015

69 refugee families received payments for the reconstruction of totally damaged homes
