
EDUCATION FACILITIES DAMAGE ASSESSMENT IN GAZA STRIP, OCCUPIED PALESTINIAN TERRITORY

This map illustrates satellite-detected damage and destruction of education facilities in Gaza Strip, resulting from recent conflicts in the area. Using satellite imagery collected 14 August 2014 and 27-28 August 2014 by the Pleiades satellite, and compared with a pre-crisis Pleiades image collected 6 July 2014, UNOSAT analysis has identified 1 destroyed structure, 10 severely damaged structures, 20 moderately damaged structures from a total of 467 schools in the Gaza Strip. The Governorate of Gaza represents 55% of the total damaged school structures. This is a preliminary analysis & has not yet been validated in the field. 
