Letter dated 3 June 1991 from the Permanent Representative
of Lebanon to the United Nations addressed to the
Secretary-General

On instructions from my Government, and pursuant to our previous letters concerning repeated Israeli attacks against Lebanon, I inform you that Israeli military aircraft today carried out a further raid on the town of Myey-o-Myeh, near Sidon. As a result, three people were killed, seven others injured and extensive damage was done to buildings and property.

In affirming that it condemns and deplores this attack, which constitutes a blatant act of defiance against international laws and conventions, the Lebanese Government once again calls upon the States members of the Security Council - and particularly the five permanent members - to take serious action to end Israel's disdain for the sovereignty of Lebanon and the safety of its citizens and those residing in its territory, as well as serious action to implement Security Council resolution 425 (1978), which provides for Israel's withdrawal from southern Lebanon and the extension of the Lebanese State's sovereignty throughout its territory.

I should be grateful if the present letter were distributed as an official document of the forty-sixth session of the General Assembly, under item 35 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
