SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3622nd meeting, held on 29 January 1996 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL) for the period from 20 July 1995 to 22 January 1996 (S/1996/45).

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/58) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/58 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1039 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1039 (1996); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).

The President then stated that, following consultations among members of the Security Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1996/5; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3626th meeting, held on 31 January 1996 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the letter dated 26 January 1996 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1996/66 and Add.1).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Croatia, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/70) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council then proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/70 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1043 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1043 (1996); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).

Letter dated 9 January 1996 from the Permanent Representative of Ethiopia to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council concerning the extradition of the suspects wanted in the assassination attempt on the life of the President of the Arab Republic of Egypt in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, on 26 June 1995 (S/1996/10)

By a letter dated 9 January 1996 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1996/10), the Permanent Representative of Ethiopia to the United Nations requested, in accordance with Article 35 of the Charter of the United Nations, an urgent meeting of the Security Council "in view of the Government of the Republic of the Sudan's refusal to comply with repeated demands for extradition to Ethiopia of the terrorists sought for their role in the assassination attempt against President Mubarak of Egypt and the serious implications of such non-compliance".

The Security Council met to consider the item at its 3627th meeting, held on 31 January 1996, in response to the above request.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Ethiopia, Pakistan and the Sudan, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/69) submitted by Botswana, Chile, Egypt, Guinea-Bissau, Honduras and Indonesia.

The Security Council then proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/69 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1044 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1044 (1996); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).
