SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3716th meeting, held on 27 November 1996, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Preventive Deployment Force pursuant to Security Council resolution 1058 (1996) (S/1996/961).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1996/979), which had been submitted by France, Germany, Italy, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1996/979, which received 14 votes in favour, to none against, with one abstention (Russian Federation) and was adopted as resolution 1082 (1996) (for the text, see S/RES/1082 (1996); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fifty-first Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1996).
