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LETTER DATED 21 SEPTEMBER 1989 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF LEBANON TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, and further to my previous letters concerning Israeli attacks against Lebanon, I regret to inform you that at 1550 hours local time yesterday, Wednesday, 20 September 1989, Israel committed a fresh act of aggression when its warplanes strafed the hills near the village of Naameh, 20 kilometres south of the capital, Beirut. Their rocket and shell bombardment killed three persons and wounded six others.

In condemning and deploring this new act of aggression against Lebanese territory, the Lebanese Government calls the attention of the international community to Israel's continued violation of Lebanese sovereignty and territorial integrity and defiance of international law and customs.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter distributed as a document of the Security Council.
