Colombia, Côte d'Ivoire, Cuba, Ethiopia, Malaysia, Yemen and Zaire: draft resolution

The Security Council,

<u>Having considered</u> the grave situation in Jerusalem arising from the incidence of violence in the precinct of Al Haram Al Shareef on 8 October 1990 resulting from the loss of lives of unarmed Palestine civilians,

Reaffirming that the Geneva Convention relative to the Protection of Civilian Persons in Time of War, of 12 August 1949, is applicable to the Palestinian and other Arab territories occupied by Israel since 1967, including Jerusalem,

Deploring the acts of violence committed by Israeli authorities,

Gravely concerned and alarmed by the deteriorating situation in the Palestinian territory occupied by Israel since 1967, including Jerusalem,

- 1. <u>Decides to establish</u> a Commission consisting of three members of the Security Council, to be dispatched immediately to examine the current situation in Jerusalem:
- 2. Requests the Commission to submit its report to the Security Council by 20 October 1990, containing recommendations on ways and means for ensuring the safety and protection of the Palestinian civilians under Israeli occupation;
- 3. Requests the Secretary-General to provide the Commission with the necessary facilities to enable it to carry out its mission;
- 4. <u>Decides</u> to keep this situation under constant and close scrutiny and to reconvene to review it in the light of the findings of the Commission.
