Supplementary information received by the Secretary-General

1. General Bull, Chief of Staff of UNTSO, has reported that as of 3 July 1967, the situation in general continued quiet along the cease-fire lines between Israel and Syria.
2. During the period from 1 to 3 July the Israel side reported that a group of Syrian soldiers had crossed the CFL and had opened fire and that the fire had been returned. The Syrian side reported that Israel military positions had fired across the CFL towards Syrian positions. The United Nations Military Observers confirmed both reports which they indicated referred to a same incident.
3. No United Nations Military Observers are stationed in the Suez area and therefore there is no reporting by United Nations sources on activities along this line relating to the Security Council cease-fire.
